The Madeira Woman's Club is offering the following scholarships for the 2024 High School graduating class.

**In Memory of Nancy Klapproth Scholarship:** One \$2,000 scholarship will be awarded in memory of charter member Nancy Klapproth, who was instrumental in starting the Scholarship Program. Applicants must be planning to obtain a four-year degree from an accredited college or university. The application must include your high school transcript and two letters of recommendation (one can be from a teacher and the other must be from sources outside of school, no relatives.)

**The Madeira Woman's Club Community College Scholarship in Honor of Kimberly Capehart:** One \$2,000 scholarship for students planning to attend an accredited two-year community college or an accredited two-year career program. The application must include your high school transcript and two letters of recommendation (one can be from a teacher and the other must be from sources outside of school, no relatives.)

**In Memory of Jane Bavely University of Cincinnati Scholarship:** One \$1,500 scholarship will be awarded in memory of Madeira Woman's Club member, Jane Bavely. Applicants must be enrolled in a University of Cincinnati four-year degree program. The application must include your high school transcript and two letters of recommendation (one can be from a teacher and the other must be from sources outside of school, no relatives.)

These scholarships are open to any Madeira resident graduating in 2024. Students should return the completed application, transcript and two letters to Madeira Woman's Club post-marked no later than March 15, 2024. Winners will be notified the week of April 22, 2024.
